VENUE OF THE EVENT

The first part of the visit will take place at **Aquincum Hotel Budapest** (Budapest, Árpád fejedelem útja 94., <https://www.aquincumhotel.com/>), close to the Danube and to the beautiful Margaret Island.

You'll find information signs in the lobby.

Buses to the other programmes will depart from this hotel as well.

HOW TO GET TO THE VENUE FROM THE AIRPORT

AIRPORT SHUTTLE:

We recommend you to use Minibud Airport Shuttle, as it gives you a door-to-door transport for a reasonable price. Airport Shuttle costs 8.800 HUF/person (appr. 28 EUR) or 10.900 HUF/ 2 passengers (approx. 39 EUR) for a return travel to Aquincum Hotel. You can book and pay your shuttle online. TAXI:

Price of the taxi is appr. 9.000 HUF (appr. 29€) for one-way to the hotel. You will find the official airport taxi stand in front of the terminal.

Public Transport:

BKK runs a direct shuttle bus from the Liszt Ferenc Airport to the city centre. The number of this bus is 100E. Get off at Astoria. From here,



take bus nr.9 to the direction of Óbuda Bogdáni út, to Kiscelli utca. You can find more information at <http://bkk.hu/en/airport-shuttle/> Customer Service Points of BKK at Liszt Ferenc International Airport can be found at Terminal 2A (daily 8:00-22:00) and Terminal 2B (daily 9:00-21:00). Vending machines operate 24/7 at the airport bus stop.

Please note that 100E is available with a special ticket, which is 900 HUF (appr. 3 EUR). The price of the normal ticket is 350 HUF (1,2 €).

HOW TO GET TO THE VENUE FROM OTHER HOTELS?

GETTING AROUND

TAXI: Licensed Budapest taxis have a uniform yellow design and same prices, regardless of the company they belong to. You'll also find a sign stating that on their side. Please look out for them and don't choose a taxi that is not licensed.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Budapest has a dense public transport system. You can get your tickets by cash or bank card at BKK (Centre for Budapest Transport) Service Points at the airport and railway stations or from purple vending machines at most of the stops. FIELD VISIT ON DAY1

A bus will take us to Kecskemét to the field visit. Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Although we ordered the nice weather, don't forget to bring your umbrella. After the field visit, the group will be taken to a special "csárda", where traditional Hungarian food and drinks will be served.

DAY 2 / OMÉK

Again, a bus will take us to the venue of OMÉK. Bus will depart from Hotel Aquincum. During the morning, some company booths will be visited. Then, you will be given some free time to look around and enjoy the special atmosphere of the fair. The Symposium will start at 14:00 and it will be held in Pávilon Nr 25.

HOW TO GET TO THE AIRPORT FROM OMÉK

AIRPORT SHUTTLE: If you decided to use the Minibud system, you can give Hungexpo Gate 1 as the collection point for the return journey.

TAXI: We will help you ordering a taxi.



Public Transport:

From OMÉK, you can take bus nr. 10 to Örs vezér tere, where Metro line 2 can be reached. Take the metro to Deák Ferenc tér, then take the direct airport bus (nr. 100) to Liszt Ferenc Airport.
