## HOW TO GET AROUND:

### From the airport:

-  SBAHN: from Munich Airport take S8 or S1 to Munich **Main Station or Munich East**  
TICKET: Single ticket (11.50 €) Single day ticket “entire network” (13.00 €)

**From within the city**, you can use the following means of public transport to reach the Bavarian Ministry of Economic Affairs:

-  METRO: Line 4 or 5 from Main Station, Odeonsplatz or Munich East.  
Exit at **Lehel** station
-  TRAM: Tram Line 16 from Sendlinger Tor, Isartor.  
Exit at **Nationalmuseum / Haus der Kunst** stop
- TICKET: Single ticket (3.30€) or Single day Ticket “inner district” (7.80 €)

**At the end of the event**, the bus will bring us back to Munich city center.

If you wish, we can also arrange a stop at the Munich Airport. Please indicate in the registration form, if you like to use this option.
