### Overall objective

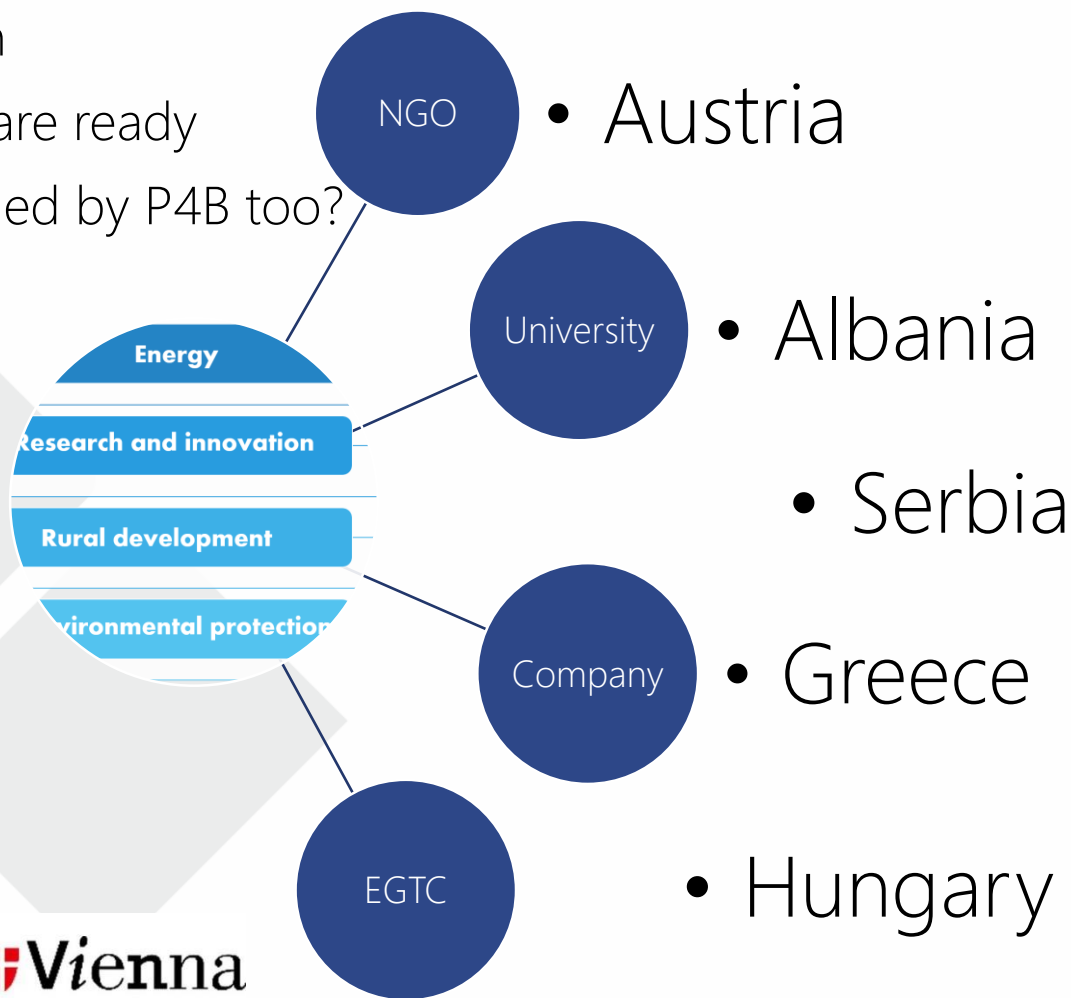
