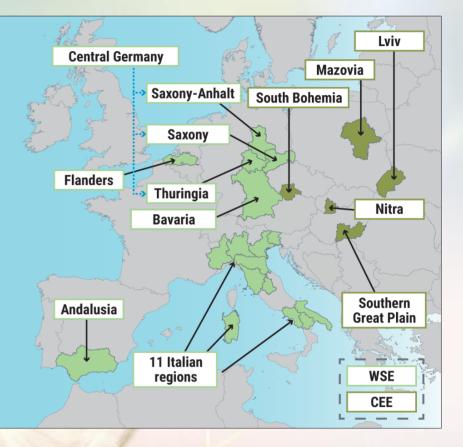

Online POWER4BIO cross-visits and trainings - problems encountered:

- Field visits of best practice examples are impossible
- It is hard to attract participants due to competition of interesting events
- Interaction between participants is lacking
- Some stakeholders are «ghosting»

Online POWER4BIO cross-visits and trainings - solutions adopted:

- Show videos of best practice examples
- Make events short and with a clear focus
- Engage participants by the use of e.g. Mentimeter
- Try to stay in direct contact with the stakeholders by phone or email, be patient

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Our recommendations and key elements of success:

- Prepare events well
 - Offer interesting content that is of value for your participants
 - In one or more test runs presenters should become familiar with the tools used
- Disseminate events well
 - Directly contact your important stakeholders and personally invite them
 - Share your event on social media and use the reach of related organisations and initiatives
- Expect the unexpected and be prepared



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
