



Average monthly gross salary compared to the national average in 2019 (Poland = 100)




GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT [CURRENT PRICES]

BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

Warsaw – operational centre and headquarters of major political, governmental and financial institutions of Poland

854 500 Entities of the national economy in the REGON register, including:

- 295 000 Legal persons and organizational entities without legal personality. and
- 559 500 Natural persons conducting economic activity including 33 200 companies with foreign capital participation;

It constitutes 40% of the total number of companies with foreign capital operating in Poland



AGRO-FOOD INDUSTRY AT MASOVIA

- Biggest concentration of the rural area of the country Rural area occupies 67% area of the voivodeship
- 13% rural area of Poland
- 36% orchards of Poland
- Fruits' National Champion
- ✓ Close to 50% of Polish apples grow at Masovia
- ✓ Close to **40% fruits export** of Poland
- Leader in the production of vegetables, meat and milk







AGRO-FOOD INDUSTRY AT MASOVIA





Masovia is a fruits export leader particularly due to high volume of its tree grown fruits export


In this category, Mazovian entrepreneurs export 27% of [Poland] products intended for **non-EU markets**

Remaining part of the fruit production is consumed at the **EU** and at the **national market** [24% only for Poland] – as processed products or in direct sale.





INDUSTRIAL STRUCTURE OF MASOVIA – EXPORT BY INDUSTRY



INDUSTRIAL STRUCTURE OF MASOVIA – ESPORT BY DESTINATION COUNTRY






