LATVIAN FOOD BIOECONOMY CLUSTER



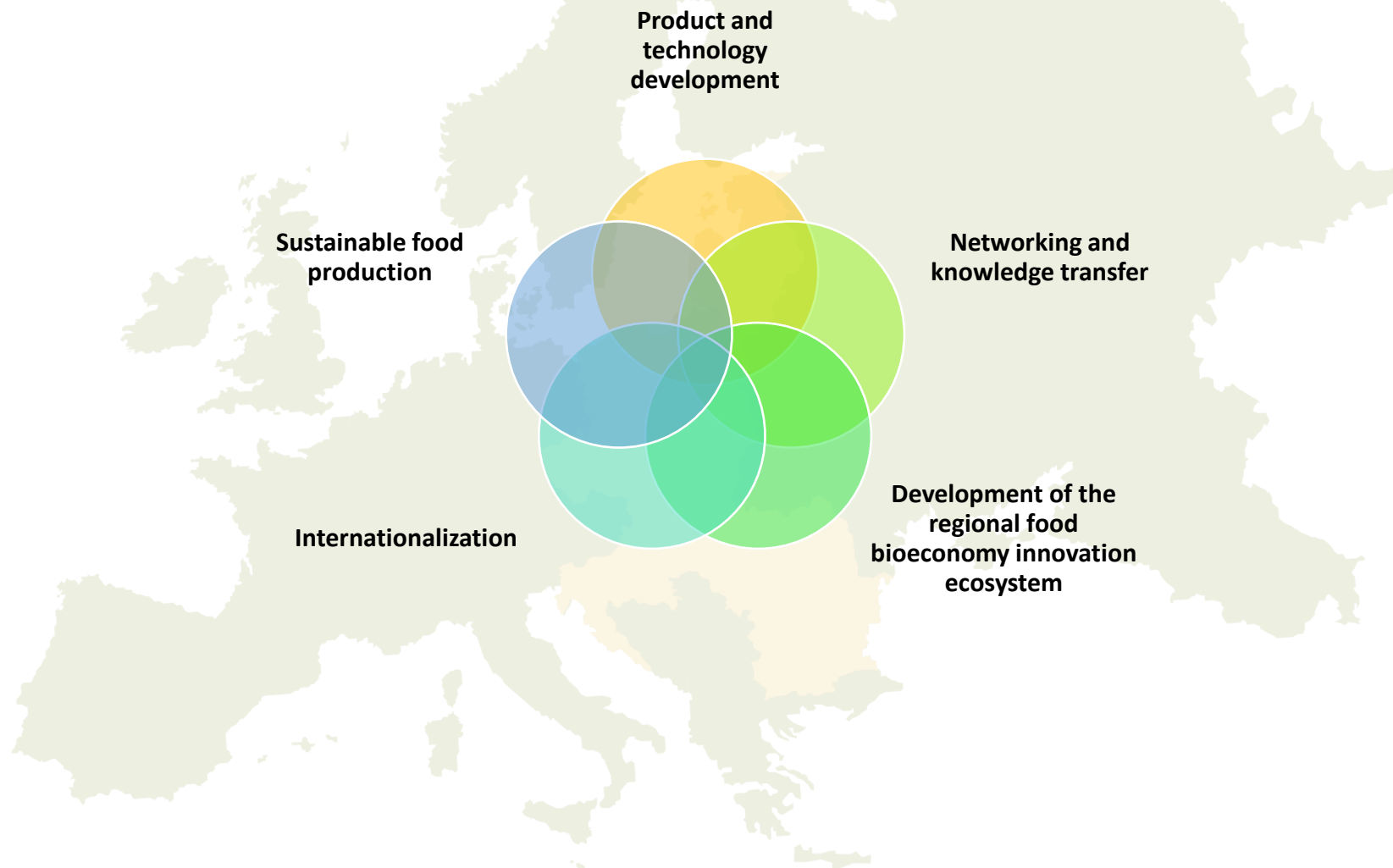

- To promote scientific and industrial cooperation both locally and internationally.

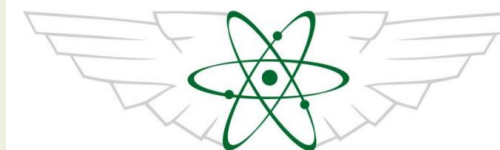

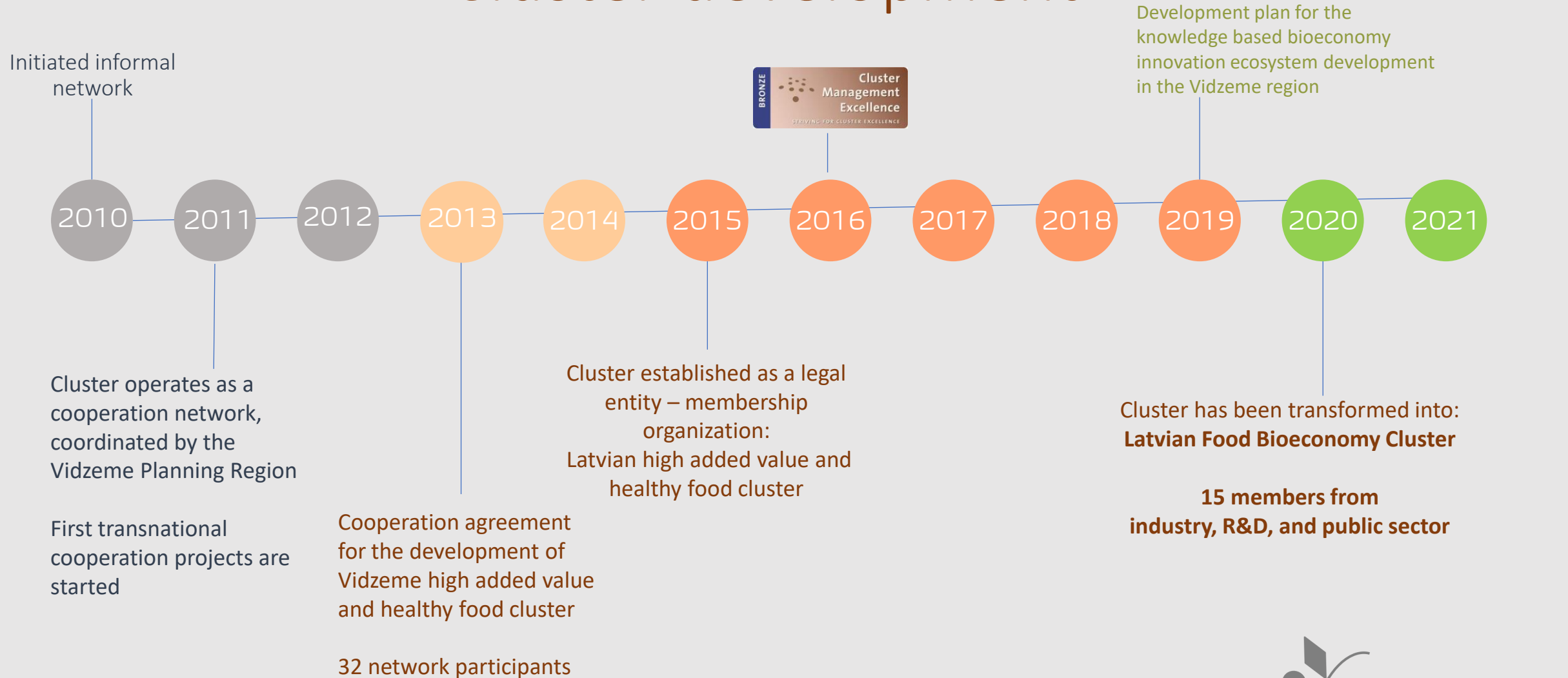
